

Dispensing Medication in School

The way we are dispensing medication in school is changing. ***Any time a pupil requires non prescribed ad-hoc medication, parents/carers will be required to give consent each and every time this needs to occur.*** If you wish to provide prior consent to medication on any given day, this can be done using the form (explained below) in the morning prior to your child coming to school.



If a child comes to see us asking for medication, we will notify you of this via the app and await for the consent form to be completed before we will administer any medication.

The only method that this consent can be given is via the school app either on your phone or computer. This is to improve the safeguarding of your child. You will be required to provide a digital signature each time you wish to give this consent.

No medication should ever be carried by pupils at any time. If you wish to provide us with any medication to dispense to your child, you must bring this to Reception and complete relevant forms.

The way we provide daily medication which has been prescribed by a GP will not change.

To access the form, you will need to sign into the App or visit <https://app.weduc.co.uk/>, select Complete and Submit Forms - select the arrow next to your name - select "Available forms" and then finally select the "Consent to Medication" form.
